

HOW TO USE THE MUSIC MAKERS WEBSITE:

1. Start your Internet Web Browser:

- a. ENTER the website address, <http://www.themusicmakers.info>, in the web address box at the top left corner of the web browser. Do not enter the web address into the SEARCH box.
- b. PRESS the ENTER key.
- c. You should be at The Music Makers Website.

2. The HOME PAGE will open:

- a. CLICK on "STUDENTS", the "LOGIN" page will open.
- b. ENTER your "LOGIN". It will be the first four letters of your LAST NAME
- c. ENTER your "PASSWORD". You received your password in class.
- d. CLICK "SUBMIT". This will take you to the "MUSIC" page.
- e. The Music is divided into "UKULELE" or "GUITAR".
- f. CLICK on the "PLAYLIST", this will open the Playlist in PDF format.
- g. To PRINT the Playlist, PRESS the printer icon at the top left of the page.
- h. Compare the music listed on the Playlist with what you already have.
- i. CLICK on the NEW or REVISED music to PRINT or COPY. If you COPY, a dialog box will open asking where you want to save the file on your computer.
- j. If you are missing some music, go to the NAVIGATION BAR, at the top of the page, and CLICK "UKULELE" or "GUITAR" to open the music data base.

3. Music Database:

NOTE: IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU CHOOSE "UKULELE" OR "GUITAR" AS THE DATA BASES ARE NOT THE SAME.

- a. CLICK on "UKULELE", if you want ukulele music or "GUITAR" if you want guitar music. This will open the Ukulele or Guitar Data Base.
- b. The links shown: | ABC | DEF | GHI | JKL | | TAB |, allow you to skip to the alphabetical sections of the data base. TAB is the tablature music section.
- c. Find the music you need and CLICK on the music title, this will open the playlist in PDF Format.
- d. To PRINT the music, PRESS the printer icon at the top left of the page.
- e. To COPY the music, PRESS the copy icon at the top left of the page. A dialog box will open asking where you want to save the file on your computer.

4. Other Pages in the Music Makers Website:

- a. CLICK on "PERFORMANCES" for rehearsals, Performance Playlists and upcoming performance dates.
- b. CLICK on "EVENTS" for event schedules in the local area.
- c. CLICK on "CONTACTS" to see vender information in the local area and to check the last update for the website.

5. Trouble Shooting the LOGIN:

- a. LOGIN requires NO CAPITAL LETTERS, NO SPACES, LOWER CASE ONLY
- b. LOGIN and PASSWORD places in the right spaces provided.
- c. Correct Spelling
